Descriptions

Core Courses

Dispensations: This course examines the Dispensational approach to biblical interpretation, seeking to understand how God works in world history as revealed in Scripture - past, present, and future. Special emphasis is placed on the distinctiveness of national Israel and the Church, a literal method of interpreting the Bible, and the doxological (glorifying) purpose of God through all time.

Doctrine I: This is the first course in the basic doctrine series consisting of Theology Proper: the arguments for the existence of God; the attributes of God; the names of God; the Tri-unity, God the Father, and Bibliology; revelation; inspiration; canonicity; illumination and interpretation. The doctrine courses can be taken in any sequence.

Spiritual Gifts: An in-depth study on what the New Testament has to say about spiritual gifts and the church age believer. We will take a cessationist approach to the gifts (ie. The revelatory/confirmatory/sign gifts have ceased with the completion of the New Testament but the serving and speaking gifts have continued on in the church age.

Bible Geography: This course will survey the regions and important biblical sites of Israel. The message of Scripture is grounded in the geography of the Promised Land. Through a variety of interactive media, students will gain an understanding and an appreciation for how God has used the land of Israel for His purposes throughout history.
