Throughout the Old Testament, the prophets foretold that the Messiah would come with glory (Isaiah 40:5, Haggai 2:7-9, et al.) The glory of the Lord accompanied the angels' announcement of Jesus' birth (Luke 2:9) as the angels sang glory to God (Luke 2:14). Simeon saw the Messiah bringing glory to Israel (Luke 2:32). No wonder the apostle John, in one of the earliest accounts of Jesus' life, wrote, "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14)!
