This class is an expositional study and discussion of the book of Ephesians, a letter addressed to the Christians who were attempting to live for God in the midst of utter paganism in the idolatrous city of Ephesus. Ephesians is profound, yet it clearly presents the most basic Christian truths. It is a magnificent combination of Christian doctrine and Christian duty—what God has done through Christ and what we must be and do in light of Christ's work.
