# *in* BETHLEHEM

There was a time when Bethlehem was better known for its produce than for its people. The surrounding network of hills and valleys (just south of Jerusalem) made for good, lush farmland (Ruth 1:22). That is why it received its name – a Hebrew word that means *house of bread*. While this little village appears entirely unremarkable, remember that Christians serve a God who does not “despise the day of small things” (Zech. 4:10). One day God raised up a warrior-king named David from the pasturelands of Bethlehem (1 Sam. 17:15). David famously championed the Lord’s people, providing them with safety and security and sustenance. However, the story was not finished: God promised that another Bethlehem-native would finish what King David started. The prophet Micah wrote, “From you, [Bethlehem], shall come forth for me, one who is to be ruler in Israel whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days” (Micah 5:2).

The Lord Jesus Christ is that ruler from eternity. He is this Bethlehem baby who redeems the world. He is “the bread of life” from *the house of bread*, given up for our new life (John 6:35). We trust this program will help ‘meek souls receive him still.’ Dear Christ, enter in!
